Offering a variety of recreational activities, our mission is to promote independence, dignity and quality of life. Beyond Blindness also provides financial assistance in cases of need, as well as grants and subsidies.

Our services are available to any individual who is <u>legally blind</u> and resides in South Australia. The cost for a Lifetime Membership is \$25.

Associate Membership is available for:

- people with low vision (not legally blind)
- spouse, partner or immediate family of a full Beyond Blindness member
- registered carer or support person.

The cost of an Associate Membership is \$25 annually.
