Drivers: If you wish to be a driver, you will need to undertake a Driver Assessment at no cost to you.

### Guiding Skills Training:

A short training program on how to correctly guide a person who is blind or vision-impaired.

All other training and clearances as required.  
DHS checks are required at no cost to you.

Volunteers must be okay to possibly interact with members' guide dogs/seeing eye dogs.
